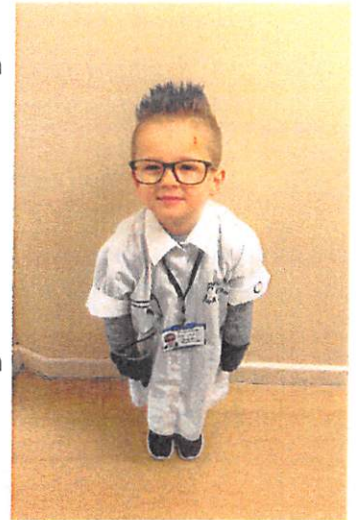


## Year 1 Den Building Day
