These sessions will work towards developing our children's reading speed and also their love of reading.

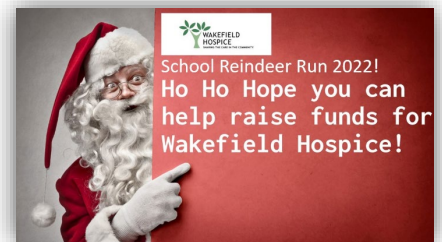


Parent Parking
