AR Book Level

We hope this letter finds you well. We are reaching out to you today about the AR book colours your children have been assigned. We understand that some of you may have noticed that the colours are lower than what your child was on last year.

We want to assure you that this is based on the results of a recent test we administered to all students. The purpose of the test was to assess each child's reading level and comprehension skills. We take these results very seriously and use them to assign appropriate reading materials to each student.

Please keep in mind that a lower colour assignment does not mean that your child is not a good reader or that they have regressed in their skills. It simply means they may need more support and guidance to improve their reading abilities. Also, as we have just had six weeks away from school, your child's comprehension skills may need refining to return to where they were in July. We encourage you to work with your child at home to help them reach their full potential.

Additionally, if your child scores 100% in five quizzes and reads at least three times a week, we will move them to the next book colour. This is a great opportunity for your child to challenge themselves and improve their reading skills.

Our morning routine includes a system where children can independently take quizzes and change AR books. We encourage your child to ensure they take advantage of this opportunity to engage with their reading material and take ownership of their learning.
