Dear Parents / Carers,

Year 4 Treak Cliff Cavern Trip

On **Wednesday 28th February 2024**, Year 4 will visit Treak Cliff Cavern in Castleton. This trip is to support their previous learning of rocks and soils in Year 3 and our Geography topic researching physical features in the UK.

Children will need to wear school uniforms and bring a suitable coat for the weather. We would suggest that children wear trainers or other suitable outdoor shoes (e.g. walking boots). Please remember that it will be very cold in the caves.

Please ensure your child arrives at school on time as the coach will be leaving at 9am to provide enough time for travelling to the location. They will be returning to school for 3.15pm so you can collect your child as normal.

Children will require a packed lunch for the day. For those who are eligible for free school meals, the school can provide a packed lunch free of charge. Please let us know whether you would like this option by contacting the school office on 01924 907430.

The total cost of this visit will be £1,350.57 which includes £625 for travel costs and £725.57 for entry fees, including a stone polishing activity. This equates to £22.51 per child.

This will be an exciting and educational experience for the children so we are asking for a voluntary contribution of **£22 per child**.

Please note that if not enough contributions are received, the trip may have to be cancelled.
