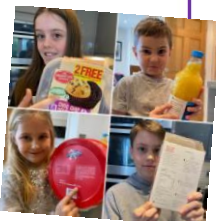
Celebrating Success

Google classrooms have been well attended over the last two weeks with some outstanding learning taking place.



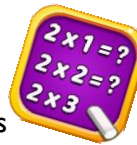
